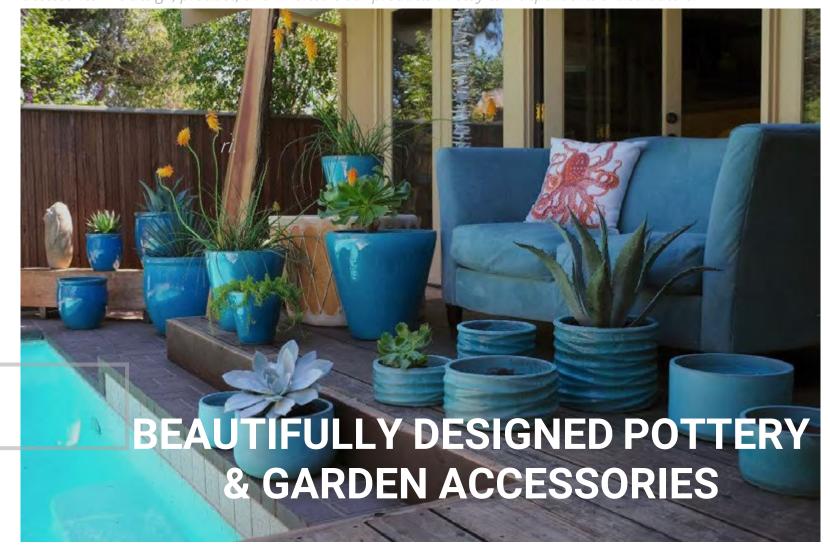

Pacific Home and Garden, Inc. ("PH Garden") is the market leader for high-end, name brand pottery and garden accessories. We design, produce, and wholesale our products directly to independent businesses and distributors.

While most pottery suppliers are simply sourcing their product, we have integrated our business with our factories and own 100% of the production. This allows us to quickly introduce new designs and be flexible with our production, to better serve our customers' needs. We import, export, and distribute our products throughout North America.

- 1. We have been working directly with the artisans in our factories, for over 20 years, to design and develop our own branded lines of pottery.
- 2. Our factories are considered the best in their respective regions and have been producing handcrafted pottery for generations. This level of quality and tradition is our foundation.
- 3. We were pioneers in creating large, outdoor ceramic planters from Vietnam. These planters have been wildly successful in the North American market.
- 4. Many pottery suppliers have brought in what is considered popular pottery styles from Europe to the U.S. market. However, because they don't understand the uniqueness of the U.S. market, most of these suppliers fail.
- 5. Our pottery is designed to suit American culture and lifestyle, as well as be functional in the varying climates throughout the U.S.
- 6. We continually redesign our product lines to reflect the changing tastes and needs of the markets we serve. Too often, U.S. pottery suppliers are beholden to the mass marketplace and source their products from "commodity factories". This leads to their products being indistinguishable from those found in big box stores. Fortunately, PH Garden utilizes unique designs and production techniques that make our pottery very difficult to copy. Our pottery is truly the marriage of all four elements: earth, water, fire, and humanity.

Why our pots are so different

- 1. While other factories use a simple mix of raw clays, we are constantly remixing and refining our clay formulations to produce the best possible results.
- 2. We utilize different clay formulas to create our unique color schemes. Our glazing chemicals react differently to each clay formula, which allow us to achieve our desired colors. Because of this, our clay costs are much higher than other factories.
- 3. Our glaze formulas are secret family "recipes" that have been handed down for generations.
- 4. We use the highest end chemicals, from around the globe, to achieve our glazing formulas. Because of this, our glaze production costs are higher than other factories.
- 5. We utilize wood-fired kilns for large containers, which are uneven in temperature. This allows us to position different colors of glaze, within different areas of the kiln, to achieve optimal results. As a result of using this method, only an average of 80% of our pottery reaches their ideal color saturation. Although this is a technical challenge, it creates a product that is unique and nearly impossible to replicate. This is one of the reasons no other pottery manufacturer can achieve the range of deep and rich colors you find in our pottery.

Are the prices of pottery really high?

No. Despite our cost of production being higher than other suppliers, our pottery prices are very reasonable and offer tremendous value. Because of our partnership with our factories and year-round production, we are able to help them save money and thus receive the best pricing possible. We have streamlined our operation so there is minimum involvement between the production and our buyers. We are able to export, import, and distribute all within the same organization.

How do we sell our products?

We sell our products in a similar way to how we work with our factories. We partner with our customers to help develop more business within their markets.

For smaller accounts, we help them find the best lines and styles that fit into their price range. With our vast mix of inventory, we create a one-stop shopping experience. Instead of buying from several different vendors, they can buy a few pallets from us and get a wide variety of styles and colors at great discounts. Their costs average 20% less than similar quality products from other vendors. Our pottery lines are not only uniquely different from those found in big box stores but are also affordable. For large accounts, we help create a customized collection of pottery that targets their customer base and helps develop their markets. Instead of buying 20+ pallets from multiple vendors, they can purchase a truck load or multiple truck loads from us and realize savings between 25% to 30%. We help them get a great variety of high-end products at great prices.

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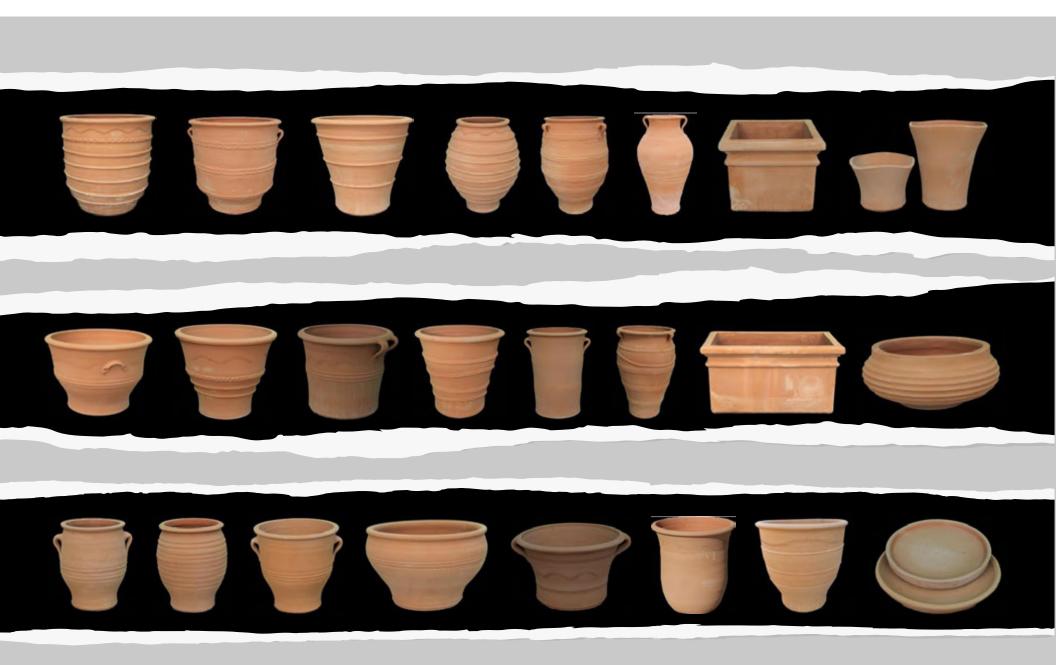

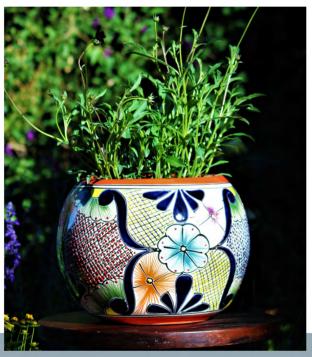
